

Curbside Recycling Information

Municipalities are required by state law to ensure that residents have access to an opportunity to recycle. The City of Ramsey accomplishes this through a contract with ACE Solid Waste for the curbside collection of recyclables. Each household is charged \$3.98 per month for recycling.


A recycling cart is available by contacting the Recycling Coordinator at 763-433-9817 or by email at canderson@cityoframsey.com. The cart will be delivered to your driveway. Recycling carts must be placed at the street by 6:30 am on the scheduled day of collection. Collection occurs on alternating Mondays for each half of the City. The City is currently divided into east and west collection zones along Nowthen Blvd and Sunfish Lake Blvd (see map below).

Acceptable Materials & Preparation

All acceptable materials can be placed directly into the recycling cart. Acceptable materials DO NOT need to be separated, but please break down cardboard boxes, cut into 3 foot by 3 foot sections and bundle them with string or twine before placing in the cart. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT PLASTIC BAGS IN THE RECYCLING CART**. The following materials are acceptable:

- Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, & phone books
- Direct mail advertising and envelopes of all types
- File folders, notebooks, and clean paper bags
- Colored paper, fax and telex sheets, and office/computer paper
- Paper cartons including milk, juice, soup and broth cartons (rinse)
- Boxboard: cereal, cake, chips, and corrugated cardboard (remove cellophane and foil liners)
- Metal food cans and aluminum beverage cans (empty and rinse)
- Glass jars and bottles (remove lids and caps; rinse)
- Plastic bottles, containers, tubs and lids 1-gallon or less in size (rinse; caps on)
